Dear ALJ Schaer:

This letter formalizes the email communication I sent yesterday to address scheduling issues. It is my understanding that the currently scheduled hearing date of December 20, 2002 is not an available date for Mr. Weber of Basin Frozen Foods. Accordingly, I am supplying alternative dates available to the parties, in the month of January 2003.
