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6	JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: So we'll go on the record.
7	Good afternoon. I'm Marguerite Friedlander,
8	administrative law judge, presiding over this proceeding. We're
9	here on January 21, 2015, for a prehearing conference in
10	Docket UT-132234, a complaint against CenturyTel of Inter
11	Island, Inc., doing business as CenturyLink, relating to a major
12	service outage.
13	We'll start today by taking appearances. We'll have
14	full appearances on the record. Give your name, spell your last
15	name, provide your mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail
16	address beginning with Staff.
17	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Good afternoon, Your Honor.
18	Appearing on behalf of Commission Staff, Jennifer
19	Cameron-Rulkowski, Assistant Attorney General.
20	My mailing address is 1400 South Evergreen Park Drive
21	Southwest, P.O. Box 40128, Olympia, Washington 98504-0128; my

24	JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. And if you want to go
25	ahead and spell your last name, too, just for the record for the

1 court reporter's purposes.

2	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Certainly. My last name is
3	spelled C-a-m-e-r-o-n, hyphen, R-u-l-k-o-w-s-k-i.
4	JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Thank you.
5	And appearing today on behalf of CenturyLink?
6	MS. ANDERL: Thank you, Your Honor. My name is Lisa
7	Anderl. My job title is senior associate general counsel for
8	CenturyLink.

13	JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Thank you.
14	And appearing today on behalf of Public Counsel?
15	MS. GAFKEN: Good afternoon. My name is Lisa Gafken,
16	G-a, "f," as in Frank, k-e-n, Assistant Attorney General,
17	appearing on behalf of Public Counsel.
18	My mailing address is 800 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2000,
19	Seattle, Washington 98104; my telephone number is 206.464.6595;

21	JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Thank you.
22	Is there anyone else today who wishes to put in an
23	appearance?
24	All right. Hearing nothing, we've had no
25	interventions, so that's fairly easy.

1 This proceeding does qualify for invocation of the discovery rules. 2 3 Do the parties wish to invoke the discovery rules? 4 MS. ANDERL: Yes, Your Honor. 5 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Thank you. Do we need a protective order in this proceeding? 6 7 MS. ANDERL: Yes, Your Honor. There may be some information that CenturyLink knows that it will be either asked 8 to or wants to provide that should be treated as confidential. 9 10 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. And so just the standard confidential standard protective order? 11 12 MS. ANDERL: Just the yellow paper. 13 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Gotcha. Gotcha. Okay. 14 Thank you. 15 Also I need to know if the parties will consent to 16 waiver of paper service so that the Commission can send any 17 documents via electric service. 18 MS. ANDERL: Yes, Your Honor. We do. 19 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. And Staff and Public 20 Counsel? 21 MS. GAFKEN: Yes, that's fine. 22 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Thank you. 23 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: That's acceptable. 24 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Thank you. 25 Okay. So we do have a proposed procedural schedule.

I I'll go ahead and read through it. I have it right in front of me, and let me know if I get anything amiss.

So we will have a settlement conference for parties only, Wednesday, February 25, 2015, and Staff direct testimony and exhibits, as well as Public Counsel direct testimony and exhibits will be due Thursday, May 7, 2015. Also on that day discovery will be seven-day business -- seven-business-day turnaround time.

9 The Company responsive testimony and exhibits will be 10 due on Thursday, June 11, 2015. Staff and Public Counsel 11 rebuttal and cross-answering testimony and exhibits will be due 12 on Thursday, July 9, 2015. Cross-examination exhibits will be 13 filed on Tuesday, July 28, 2015. Submission of 14 cross-examination times to me, the presiding officer, will be done on Thursday, July 30th. The evidentiary hearing will be 15 16 set for Wednesday, August 5, 2015.

And that will be a one-day hearing, I assume? That will be sufficient?

MS. ANDERL: That's what we thought, Your Honor.JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay.

MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: We believe so, Your Honor.
JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Thank you.

And simultaneous posthearing briefs will be due onThursday, September 17, 2015.

25 Did I get everything?

1 MS. GAFKEN: Yes. 2 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Perfect. 3 So is there anything else that we need to take up 4 procedurally? 5 MS. ANDERL: Your Honor, we were wondering -- or 6 maybe you'll put it in the prehearing conference order, but how 7 many paper copies do we need to provide to the Commission? JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Absolutely. An original and five 8 for unredacted, and an original and two for -- I'm sorry. For 9 10 unredacted it's an original and five. For redacted, it's an 11 original and two copies. MS. ANDERL: Oh, okay. I thought it was an original 12 13 and one for redacted but... 14 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Yeah. I think we're doing now original and two just in case. I have seen that in other 15 16 prehearing conference orders, and that's my understanding, so 17 we'll go ahead and stick with that, an original and two for the 18 redacted and an original and five copies for the unredacted. 19 MS. ANDERL: And, Your Honor, there was just one 20 thing that I wanted to note. 21 When Ms. Gafken and Ms. Cameron-Rulkowski and I were 22 talking, we did have a bit of discussion about the deadline for 23 discovery responses. 24 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. MS. ANDERL: And I agreed to this schedule, but I do 25

1 want to make it clear that we do still need to have the protection of the discovery rule that allows you to advise a 2 3 party before the deadline if you can't answer in time, and then 4 to answer as soon as possible after that. 5 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Right. 6 MS. ANDERL: Sometimes the shortened time frames in a 7 large company with turnaround around and review, sometimes it's difficult to meet those even if the answers are reasonably 8 9 readily available, and it's almost impossible to meet those 10 deadlines if you have to dig for the answers. 11 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Right. Okay. Well, I imagine. 12 Did Public Counsel or Staff have anything they wanted 13 to add? 14 MS. GAFKEN: Yeah. We did discuss this, and Public 15 Counsel noted -- and I'll let Staff speak for themselves -- but, 16 you know, Public Counsel's always willing to talk with parties 17 about discovery response times, and we understand that sometimes 18 you run into some difficulty responding with them in the 19 allotted time. 20 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Great. 21 And, Staff, did you have anything to add? 22 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Staff agrees with Public Counsel in that respect. 23 24 JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Thank you.

25 And I'm sure you guys will bring something to my

attention if there's any discovery disputes or disagreement as to dates, so is there anything else that we need to address before we adjourn? MS. GAFKEN: Not from Public Counsel, Your Honor. JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. MS. GAFKEN: Thank you. MS. ANDERL: I don't think so. JUDGE FRIEDLANDER: Okay. Great. Well, thank you very much, and we are adjourned. (Proceeding concluded at 2:08 p.m.) -000-
