Greetings my Lady and Gentlemen (serving as Utilities Commission Members):

I write you with appreciation knowing that your mission as stated on your website is to **protect the people of Washington** by ensuring that investor-owned utility and transportation services are SAFE (my emphasis), available reliable and fairly priced.

I am a medical doctor and resident of Island County for the past 26 years and understand PSE is planning to begin install new "smart" (non-analogue) meters soon in our area. To be clear, knowing what I know of these meters, I refer to them as "dumb and dangerous" and not "smart".

You will be hearing a lot from our concerned citizens but I want to write you as a medical doctor and as a clinician who can vouch for the fact that the <u>syndrome of electronic sensitivity is a very real and debilitating syndrome.</u> It is real and it angers people when the installation of a "dumb and dangerous" meter starts to cause pain and suffering.

You will hear perhaps from many people who assert that these "dumb and dangerous" meters are safe. The science is clear that they are not safe. We will muster that science in Washington State as our colleagues have in other states and we will rebuff efforts to force citizens to accept these "dumb and dangerous" meters (aka "digital radio frequency meters" aka "AMI meters" (Advanced Metering Infrastructure). Please honor your oath of office as commissioners to uphold the Washington State constitution and to protect the welfare of the citizens who you have sworn to protect. If, on the other hand, you genuinely believe what you have been told by corporate (i.e. biased) entities that these

"dumb and dangerous" meters are safe, please take a few minutes to review any of these websites. At the very least, your effort to look for yourself will inspire curiosity on your part and open the door for more meaningful discussions about safety of these "dumb and dangerous" meters.
