- 2. Public Comment Exhibit No. BR-10. The exhibit consists of letters, e-mails, a petition, online submissions, and other written comments submitted by the public to comment on the Puget Sound Energy (PSE) increase of rates and charges for electric and natural gas service. The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") and the Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Attorney General's Office ("Public Counsel") received and compiled these comments.
 - PSE customers provided comments via telephone, e-mail, mail, in-person, and through the Commission's online comment web portal.
