TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On March 7, 2007, Qwest and MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services (Verizon Access) submitted to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a joint motion to approve a settlement agreement and to dismiss Qwest's complaint as to Verizon Access. Qwest and Verizon access also filed a narrative supporting the settlement agreement.

The schedule of proceedings for this case calls for evidentiary hearings to begin on April 23, 2007.

The Commission convened a scheduling conference on April 4, 2007, to address the process for reviewing the settlement agreement. The parties agreed that the Commission should review the settlement agreement during the week scheduled for evidentiary hearings. The parties further agreed that the hearing on the settlement will take place on April 27, or whatever is the day following the conclusion of hearing on the parties' cases in chief. Qwest, Verizon Access and Staff will each present a witness for cross-examination at the settlement hearing.

The parties further agreed to file exhibit lists, cross-exhibits, cross-examination time estimates and a proposed order of witnesses by noon on April 19, 2007.

**NOTICE IS GIVEN That the Commission will convene a hearing on the settlement agreement on April 27, 2007 at 9:30 a.m, or on the day immediately following cross-examination of the parties cases-in-chief during the week April 23 to April 27, 2007, at the offices of the UTC, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S. W., Olympia, Washington.**
