
Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to Order No. 2 in the above docket rejecting the Company's tariff filing, Waste Control, Inc.'s current tariffs are presently suspended and subject to investigation and potential refund. The Company's suspended filing reflects a significant revenue deficiency and because of that we are asking that the current stay be lifted for the purpose of accepting the enclosed fuel surcharge. At the Prehearing Conference in this matter on January 14, 2014, we also noted on the record that we would be seeking Commission approval to lift the stay to permit a fuel surcharge.

Were this matter not under current suspension, under the Commission's regulations in WAC 480-70, the Company would presumptively qualify for a fuel surcharge.

Therefore the applicant requests, pursuant to RCW 81.28.050 and consistent with the public interest, that the current suspension Order be lifted for the sole purpose of considering and approving the fuel surcharge filing. Finally, the Company understands that no further changes to its current rates are authorized except on order of the Commission.


