RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Seattle Travel Service, LLC, in the Amount of \$14,400, Docket TE-190751

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 9, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation to \$7,250 (Order 01) against Seattle Travel Service, LLC, (Seattle Travel or Company). Order 01 imposed a penalty of \$7,250 against Seattle Travel, \$3,625 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) Seattle Travel not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations, and b) the Company timely pay the \$3,625 portion of the penalty.

On October 21, 2019, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 02). Order 02 allowed Seattle Travel to pay the portion of the penalty that was not suspended in six monthly payments ending in March 2020.

On October 21, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$3,625 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that the Company has not incurred any further violations of critical regulations.

The Commission finds that Seattle Travel has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$3,625 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
