On June 29, 1990, Sno-King Garbage Company, Inc., G-126 filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission revisions to its tariff to become effective August 1, 1990.

On July 30, 1990, the filing was suspended to allow for further investigation to ensure the rights and interests of the public would not be injuriously affected.

On July 30, 1990, the Commission ordered temporary rates subject to refund be allowed.

On January 11, 1991, an order was served authorizing a change in corporate name from Sno-King Garbage Company, Inc., to Waste Management - Sno-King, Inc.

On February 22, 1991, a petition was received from the company seeking authorization to amend rates in Item 100 of the suspended filing. The petition seeks to establish rates for curbside collection of residential yard waste in the suburban and urban portions of Snohomish County.

At the Commission's open public meeting of March 6, 1991, Commission staff recommended granting the yard waste collection petition.

Having given full consideration to the petition, the staff evaluation and recommendations, the Commission finds that it is in the public interest to grant the company's petition to be allowed to amend Item 100 to include rates for yard waste collection.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That Waste Management - Sno-King, Inc., G-126 (formerly known as Sno-King Garbage Co., Inc.) shall be allowed to amend Item 100 of the filing suspended in Docket No. TG-900657. Such amendment shall be limited to those changes contained in filing Docket No. TG-910203.

IT IS ORDERED That the amended rates shall become effective on March 7, 1991 on less than statutory notice.

IT IS ORDERED That the rates shall expire on September 30, 1992.

IT IS ORDERED That filing TG-900657 shall remain suspended pending investigation and that no further changes may be made in the suspended rates during the period of the suspension or any extension, unless specifically authorized by the Commission.
