**FIX PUGET SOUND ENERGY'S BAD GAS PLAN**

*Want to pay more for utility bills, while doubling down on fossil fuels for the next quarter-century?*

That's what Puget Sound Energy (PSE)'s latest plan looks like — and it's hard to overstate how bad this plan is for customer energy costs, the environment, and future generations. Consider this: PSE will charge customers over \$10 billion so they can buy carbon allowances and burn natural gas, permitting vast quantities of pollution during the next quarter-century. Ten billion dollars exceeds the cost of maintaining and modernizing the energy grid over that period. And to get here, PSE rejected viable, alternative plans that would achieve real emissions reductions, stabilize energy costs, and avoid unproven technologies.
