The affected chapters are: Chapter 480-90 WAC Natural Gas Utilities Chapter 480-100 WAC Electric Utilities Chapter 480-120 WAC Telecommunications Companies, and WAC 480-121-065 Customer notice requirements, Petition for competitive classification of a service.
