On behalf of NW Natural, attached is a memorandum requesting the establishment of a regulated navigation area (RNA) at the NW Natural Gasco Sediments Site Project Area (Site) located in the Willamette River in Portland, Oregon. This request is pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 33, Part 165. The proposed RNA will preserve the integrity of the In Situ Stabilization and Solidification (ISS) Field Pilot Study (FPS) post-construction sampling ports placed over a portion of the Site as part of a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Superfund cleanup action. This memorandum proposes to prohibit activities that could disturb the sampling ports, which will be placed to measure potential diffusive flux of contaminants from the surface of ISS treated sediments.
