On Friday, April 25, 2003, Verizon Northwest Inc. filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Ninth Supplemental Order to allow Verizon to submit the surrebuttal testimony of Heuring, Trimble and Simmons on the issue of earnings. Verizon inadvertently failed to include portions of Orville D. Fulp's surrebuttal testimony in that motion. For the reasons stated in that Motion, Verizon also requests that page 4, line 12 through and including page 10, line 2 of Orville D. Fulp's surrebuttal testimony that deal with earnings also be allowed.
