1. Take appearances of counsel
2. Address petitions to intervene, if any
3. Consider the validity and scope of the protest, and whether the parties agree that the scope of the protest should be deemed consistent with the scope of the protest defined in the June 7, 2004, Order No. 02 in re Application No. B-079273 of Aqua Express, LLC. In the absence of agreement, hear parties' argument on the subject.
4. Determine the issues to be addressed in the brief adjudication, based on the law, the rules, the protest, and the notice of hearing.
5. Discuss the process for the brief adjudication, considering the pertinent laws and rules—especially RCW 34.05.485(2) and WAC 480-07-610(5), the procedural setting, and the structure of brief adjudications. Consider whether any written evidence will be offered and whether it may be received by stipulation of the parties. Consider whether any party wishes to provide oral statements in the nature of evidence. Consider whether parties wish to provide oral argument and, if so, the length of time desired.
6. Consider whether the parties will consent to shortening the time for requests for administrative review and responses.
7. Take up other procedural matters that the parties wish to address.
