- 1 The Administrative Law Judge entered Order 02 in this matter on August 30, 2006.
- 2 The Commission notifies the parties that it intends to review the initial order if no party seeks administrative review pursuant to the authority in RCW 80.01.060(3) and WAC 480-07-825(8). The Commission intends to review the initial order, including the sanctions proposed in the initial order. The Commission will consider whether those sanctions are appropriate in light of the factual record regarding violations committed, or whether the sanctions should be modified in a final order.
- 3 Parties are entitled to petition for administrative review on any issues and to answer any petitions. Parties may also address the issue identified above in their petitions or answers or in independent statements of position filed on the same schedule.
- 4 The Commission extends the time for filing petitions for administrative review. Such petitions or opening statements of position are due **September 29, 2006**, and answers or responding statements of position are due **October 13, 2006**.
