Under RCW.19.285.040(2)(a)(ii) and WAC 480-109-200(1)(b), the 2021 renewable energy target for Puget Sound Energy (“PSE” or the “Company”), is 3,069,109 megawatt-hours.¹ Under RCW 19.285.040(2)(a), each qualifying utility shall use eligible renewable resources or acquire equivalent renewable energy credits (“RECs”), or a combination of both, to meet annual renewable targets. Please see Attachment 1 for the renewable generation acquired and/or the RECs (including associated Extra Apprenticeship Credits and Distributed Generation two times multipliers when applicable) retired for PSE’s 2021 compliance year summarized by vintage year and fuel type.

The corresponding retired WREGIS certificates are listed in Attachment 2 to this Report. Attachment 3 details which certificates PSE used for its voluntary renewable energy programs in 2021.

As a reminder, the distributed generation multiplier for Hidden Hollow was approved last year in PSE’s Docket UE-220405.
