ORDER 02

CANCELING PAYMENT
ARRANGEMENT

BACKGROUND

- 1 On April 22, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 01 (Order 01) Consolidating Dockets; Approving Safety Management Plan; Extending Provisional Period; Mitigating Penalty in the Matter of the Investigation of PNW Moving and Delivery, LLC (PNW Moving or Company) for compliance with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15.
- 2 On March 8, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter to the docket, noting that the Company had missed five scheduled payments under its payment plan, and it had not made a payment since December 19, 2023. Staff requests that the Commission cancel the payment arrangement, making the entire remaining balance of \$9,800 immediately due and payable.

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

- 3 We agree with Staff that the payment arrangement should be cancelled. Given the Company's failure to make five payments in a timely manner, Staff has properly moved for cancellation of the payment arrangement consistent with WAC 480-07-915(8)(b).

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 4 (1) The payment arrangement granted to PNW Moving and Delivery, LLC in Order
01 is hereby cancelled.
- 5 (2) The remaining balance of \$9,800 is immediately due and payable.
- 6 The Secretary has been delegated authority to enter this order on behalf of the
Commissioners under WAC 480-07-904(1)(h).
