## NOTICE CANCELING SETTLEMENT HEARING

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Clutter, Inc., Docket TV-200432

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 25, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Prehearing Conference (Complaint) against Clutter, Inc. (Clutter or Company), which alleged that Clutter violated Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15 a total of 390 times. The Complaint scheduled a prehearing conference for Tuesday, May 4, 2021.

On May 5, 2021, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 02) in this docket, which established a procedural schedule including an evidentiary hearing set for July 26, 2021.

On June 11, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket to inform the Commission that Staff and the Company (collectively, the Parties) had reached a full settlement in principle and requested that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule.

On June 25, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice Suspending Procedural Schedule, which required the Parties to submit a proposal for a revised procedural schedule that allowed for consideration of the settlement by July 2.

On July 2, 2021, the Parties filed a proposed revised procedural schedule that included a settlement hearing and post-settlement briefs, and on July 7, the Commission issued a Notice Revising Procedural Schedule which, among other things, set a settlement hearing for July 26.

On July 20, 2021, Public Counsel contacted the presiding officer to inform the Commission that Public Counsel would neither join nor oppose the settlement, and that the parties agree a hearing is not necessary.

Based on the Parties' agreement, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the settlement hearing set for July 26, 2021, and the post-settlement briefs due August 18, 2020. The Commission will review the settlement documents filed by the Parties and decide this matter based on a paper record.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That the Commission hereby cancels the procedural schedule in this Docket, including the Settlement Hearing scheduled for July 26, 2021, at 10 a.m.
