- 1. TRACER hereby submits its Reply Brief in the above-captioned matter. TRACER concurs with the positions and arguments regarding HUNE pricing articulated in the Part A Post Hearing Reply Brief of Covad Communications Company and Rhythms Links Inc. TRACER believes that the analysis set forth in that brief, together with its own analysis contained in TRACER's opening brief, form a sound basis on which this Commission can conclude that setting a zero price for the HUNE comports with good public policy and the applicable law. In particular, TRACER agrees with the analysis contained in the Rhythms and Covad reply brief in which the companies argue that a zero HUNE price does not violate Section 254(k) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2. In addition, TRACER again urges this Commission to take into account the interstate nature of DSL services when setting a price for the HUNE. As explained in its opening brief, under the FCC's jurisdictional separations process, only 25% of loop costs are to be recovered from services under interstate jurisdiction. Therefore, assuming that there *are* loop costs which are joint and common between voice and DSL services, then a *maximum* of 25% of the joint and common costs of the loop can be recovered from DSL services.

3. TRACER does not believe that *any* loop costs are joint and common to DSL services.

However, to the extent that the Commission may disagree, and further, to the extent that the

Commission may wish to allocate a reasonable amount of joint and common loop costs to the

HUNE, then an appropriate inquiry into whether the HUNE is bearing its fair share of such joint loop

costs would focus on whether the HUNE was bearing a reasonable share of the 25% of loop costs

allocated to interstate services.

4. Public Counsel's suggestion that a positive price for the HUNE should be adopted and that

a reasonable price would fall between 50% of the common costs included in the UNE loop cost and

50% of the entire loop cost adopted by the Commission fails to consider the jurisdictional allocation

process. Any allocation of loop costs to the HUNE would necessarily be based on some fraction of

25% of the loop cost, and not based on a fraction of the entire loop cost. For that reason alone, Public

Counsel's reasoning is flawed and should be rejected.

5. For the above-stated reasons, TRACER continues to urge the Commission to set the price

for the HUNE at zero.
