Dear Mr. Perkins:

As you are aware, on September 12, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 01, Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties, against Emerald City Party Bus for violations of RCW 81.70.220, transporting passengers without the necessary permit. On October 10, 2016, the Commission issued Order 02 imposing a \$20,000 penalty, and suspending \$16,000 on the condition of future compliance. The Commission issued Order 03, dated December 7, 2016, granting Emerald City Party Bus's request for a payment arrangement. The Commission has not received a payment since May 15, 2017. The Commission sent Emerald City Party Bus a Final Notice, dated August 23, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$3,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$3,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$3,000 balance.
