Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On October 1, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, which assessed Paulino Jose Gonzalez and Veronic Luna d/b/a Universal Moving (Universal or Company) a penalty of \$2,000 for operating as a solid waste carrier without a certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$1,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) Universal pays the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On February 18, 2020, the Company paid the \$500 penalty in full. Universal has refrained from operating as a solid waste carrier in this state for the period described above. For these reasons, staff finds that Universal satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends the remaining \$1,500 suspended penalty be waived.
