NOTICE OF CHANGES TO TARIFF 15-C, HOUSEHOLD GOODS ESTIMATED COSTS FOR SERVICES FORM, AND BILL OF LADING

RE: In the Matter of Amending Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Tariff 15-C, Relating to Intrastate Transportation of Household Goods, Docket TV-190664

On February 20, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission approved changes to Tariff 15-C in Docket TV-190664 for the following items:

- Item 10: Definitions
- Item 50: Overtime
- Item 57: Credit Card Fee
- Item 62: Appliance Service
- Item 85: Estimates
- Item 100: Storage
- Item 105: Application of Rates
- Item 115: Weight of Shipment
- Item 155: Additional Stops
- Item 160: Long Carry

- Item 165: Stairs or Elevator
- Item 170: Piano and Organ Handling
- Item 180: Reweighing
- Item 190: Overtime
- Item 195: Packing Charges
- Item 196: Container Prices
- Item 200: Mileage Rates
- Item 201: Mileage Rates with SIT
- Item 225: Container Prices
- Item 230: Hourly Rates

Item 200 (Mileage Rates) and Item 85 (Estimates) have been updated to allow per-diem charges for shipments transported 56 miles or more where overnight stays are required. The per diem charges must be included in the written estimate and included as a line item on the bill of lading.

The credit card processing fee (Item 57) has been <u>removed</u>. For shipments moved after February 20, 2020, the credit card processing fee can no longer be charged.

Sample *Estimated Costs for Services* and *Uniform Household Goods Bill of Lading* forms are available on our website. Credit card processing fee line items have been removed from the forms, and per-diem charges for shipments transported 56 miles or more that require overnight stays have been added.
