Least Cost Planning Rules

Given the comments received to date and the discussions held at the June 3, 1999 workshop regarding the Commission's least cost planning rules -- WAC 480-90-191 and WAC 480-100-251 -- the Commission has decided to defer the review of these rules until next year. This will free the current natural gas and electric rulemaking proceedings from the major policy issues to be explored in a review of the least cost planning rules which should be considered in the context of a review of the rules in chapter 480-107 WAC, Electric Companies - Interconnection With Electric Cogeneration and Small Power Producers.
