RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Docket UG-230393

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 24, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Final Order 07, Rejecting Tariff Sheets, Requiring Compliance Filing (Final Order 07). In this Order, the Commission ruled on the request by Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) for recovery of expenses incurred in connection with the Tacoma Liquid Natural Gas (LNG) Facility. Final Order 07 required the Company to submit revised tariff sheets consistent with the Commission's findings.

On May 3, 2024, PSE filed revised tariff sheets for Natural Gas Tariff WN U-2. The revisions reflect the \$42.6 million increase in natural gas revenue requirement for the Tacoma LNG Facility, a \$2 million decrease in the revenue requirement of the four-mile pipe, and a refund to customers of \$2.8 million related to the decreased revenue requirement of the four-mile pipe.

On May 8, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter to the docket explaining that it had reviewed the Company's compliance filing. Staff believes that the revised tariff sheets, filed on May 3, 2024, comply with Order 07, entered April 24, 2024. The tariff sheets are dated to become effective May 11, 2024

The Commission agrees that PSE's May 3, 2024, filing complies with Final Order 07 and the tariff sheets as filed on May 3, 2024, will become effective as a matter of law on May 11, 2024.
