On March 5, 2018, WSDOT, BNSF, and Commission Staff attended a mediation conference in the above docket. I am authorized to report that the parties have reached a tentative agreement that will resolve this matter without a hearing. As such, the parties would request the schedule for the hearing be suspended. No later than Monday, April 9, 2018, WSDOT will file a revised Petition to Modify Highway-Rail Crossing Active Warning Devices that includes an updated plan. The revised Petition will include a signed Waiver of Hearing from BNSF. Upon receipt of the revised Petition and Waiver of Hearing, the Commission may enter an order without a hearing.
