<ul> <li>No Briefly summarize the agency's analysis showing how costs were calculated. <u>The Utilities and Transportation</u> <u>Commission is proposing to adopt rules that establish a process for setting rates, terms, and conditions for pilotage</u> <u>services that is comparable to the general ratemaking process the UTC has long used for utilities and other transportation</u> <u>companies the commission regulates</u>. On January 18, 2019, the UTC mailed a notice to all stakeholders interested in the <u>rulemaking</u>, providing a copy of the draft rules and an opportunity to respond to an SBEIS questionnaire. The notice <u>requested that entities affected by the proposed rules provide information about possible cost impacts of the rules with specific information for each rule that the entity identified as causing an impact. The UTC did not receive any information in response to the questionnaire.
