Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on April 10, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission assessed a \$6,800 penalty against Whidbey Logistics, LLC, for violations of WACs 480-15-555 and -560. On May 17, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01 granting mitigation of the penalty to \$3,550, \$1,775 of which was suspended for a period of two years, subject to conditions. On January 27, 2021, Staff filed a letter in docket TV-190111 informing the Commission that Staff discovered repeat violations of critical regulations. On February 2, 2021, the Commission issued a compliance letter imposing the \$1,775 portion of the suspended penalty.

The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated March 10, 2021, indicating that the balance of \$1,775 was due. To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you likely would incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$1,775 balance.
