1     **Proceeding.** Docket No. UT-030614 involves a petition filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), for competitive classification of basic business exchange telecommunications services pursuant to RCW 80.36.330. Qwest’s petition, filed on May 1, 2003, stated an effective date of May 31, 2003. At its open meeting on May 28, 2003, the Commission suspended the effective date and directed that there be a hearing on the petition. The provisions of RCW 80.36.310 require that the Commission act on the petition within six months of the filing date, in this case, by November 1, 2003.

2     **Prehearing Conference.** The Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington on June 6, 2003 before Administrative Law Judge Theodora Mace.

- 4 **Petitions to Intervene.** In the prehearing conference order in this docket, entered on June 9, 2003, the Commission granted the petitions to intervene of Integra, MCI, AT&T and DOD/FEA. The Commission inadvertently omitted granting the petition to intervene of WeBTEC which was made orally on the record at the prehearing conference. No party objected to WeBTEC's petition to intervene. WeBTEC's petition to intervene meets the Commission's requirements for intervention. WeBTEC's petition to intervene is granted. The schedule of proceedings established in the prehearing conference order in this docket apply to WeBTEC, as to all other parties to the proceeding. A revised Appendix A identifying the parties to the proceeding is attached to this order.
