**NOTICE OF FILING DEADLINE

Application of Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc., d/b/a Olympic Disposal for an Extension of Certificate No. G-9 for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Solid Waste Collection Service, Docket TG-091019 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

These consolidated dockets involve competing applications seeking authority to serve the same area in Olympic National Park. No one presently has permanent authority to provide solid waste transportation service in the portion of the Park known as the Hoh Quadrant.

At the initial prehearing conference held on October 12, 2009, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule with a hearing date of February 2, 2010, and a deadline of January 26, 2010, for filing of documentary evidence concerning need for the service. The Commission subsequently set a deadline of January 29, 2010, for filing of documentary evidence on other relevant subjects, such as financial or managerial fitness. To date, the only prefiled evidence filed is each competing company's submission of direct testimony from Phaedra R. Fuller concerning need for the service in the Hoh Quadrant of Olympic National Park.

On January 27, 2010, at the parties' request, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule in this matter in favor of allowing the parties time to negotiate a proposed

settlement agreement. The Commission established a deadline of March 29, 2010, for the parties to submit a settlement agreement and supporting narrative. To date, the parties have not submitted any settlement proposal.

In the case the parties failed to timely resolve their differences, the Commission scheduled an evidentiary hearing for April 15, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. In order to ensure that proceeding can proceed as planned, the Commission wishes to provide the parties with a firm deadline for submission of their witness and exhibit lists as well as the filing of any further documentary evidence that may be necessary for and relevant to the hearing.

The Commission gives notice that the parties are each required to file witness and exhibit lists as well as any additional proposed documentary evidence concerning financial fitness, managerial fitness, and any topic other than need for the service, by 12:00 Noon on Monday, April 12, 2010. Witnesses identified and documentary exhibits proffered for the first time at the evidentiary hearing without a showing of good cause as to why they were not filed in compliance with this deadline will be excluded.
