

Subject: WUTC - Washington Conservation Group - June 29th Meeting/Newest Draft of Narrative Consensus Document

To Members of the Washington Conservation Working Group -

Good morning!

From a review of your e-mails, it appears you have made some good progress this month - good work!

This is a reminder that we meet tomorrow, June 29th, from 9:30 to 4:00 at the WUTC. The primary purpose of the meeting is to assemble the results of the process, and the two summary documents you recently created will assist greatly. I will send out a detailed agenda later today after I have had a chance to confer with the Staff, but, in short, we will finalize the narrative Consensus Document, Topical Issue Summary, and Document Status summary, hear back from the Codes Subgroup and determine the status of its work product, and determine and memorialize the status of the Proposed Matrix of Reporting Schedules, the Biennial Conservation Plan Template, and the Incentives Guidelines.

The latest draft of the narrative Consensus Document is attached for your review. My thanks to NWECC, Public Counsel, PSE, and PacifiCorp for providing comments, which have been incorporated. I am providing both red-lined and clean versions, but since the document is short, I recommend you work from the clean version.
