NOTICE GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc., G-9, Respondent, Docket TG-130501, and Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. American Disposal Company, Inc., G-87, Respondent, Docket TG-130502 (consolidated)*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 21, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 02 – Prehearing Conference Order; Order of Consolidation; Notice of Status Conference; and Notice of Hearing in the above-referenced dockets establishing a procedural schedule.

On June 19, 2013, Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc. (Murrey's), and its sister company, American Disposal Company, Inc. (along with Murrey's, the Companies), and the Commission's regulatory staff (Staff) filed a request for extension with the Commission.¹ The parties state that the continuance is needed to facilitate ongoing discussions to narrow the issues. All parties have agreed to the requested continuance and provide a modified procedural schedule. The Commission finds that the parties have demonstrated good cause to continue the filing deadlines and grants the request as follows:
