The primary purpose of this filing is the addition of Light Emitting Diode (“LED”) flood lighting rates and additional LED area light rates so that PSE can offer these more efficient lights to customers on these PSE-owned facilities. The filing includes sizes of lights that manufacturers have made available due to changes in technology and efficiency of the LEDs used. Also the filing includes sizes that PSE expects manufacturers to make available along with a provision to clarify that availability is limited to the wattages that PSE has in stock.

PSE initially added two sizes of LED area lights and described them as 100 and 150 watt equivalent (“WE”) to indicate that they would give the same amount of light as a 100 and 150 watt high pressure sodium vapor (“HPS”) area light. Changes in technology and manufacturers

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offering additional and lower wattage sizes have been the drivers of this filing. The 100 WE area lights were actually the average of two wattages of area lights providing the light output equivalent to 100 watt HPS area lights. By the time the LED area lights were actually received by PSE the wattage of the 100 WE lights had dropped from those used as the basis for the December 2014, filing. Following approval of this filing billing for the lights with lower wattage will be changed to their respective 5 watt ranges.

Work papers supporting rates for the new LED flood and area lights are enclosed. Rates were derived by using the relationship between existing rates and costs for high pressure sodium street and area/flood lights and the costs for these new LED area and flood lights.

The rider rates for the new LED area light sizes are the same as for PSE-owned LED street lights of the same wattage. Rider rates for the new LED flood light sizes, some of which are larger than the sizes of PSE-owned LED street lights are based on the rate per kWh of the LED street lights. Work papers supporting the rider rates are enclosed.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of September 29, 2015, and effective dates of October 30, 2015. Posting of proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1). This filing does not increase rates or restrict access to services but instead provides for many new additional lamp sizes, therefore, no notice to customers is required by WAC 480-100-194(1).
