Good day, I am writing about DOCKET TV-220133 and TV-220134 to give my explanation as well as to ask for an extension on the payment plan. I will try to explain how I failed to make payment as well as where the company is at the moment. I will ask for an extension on making payment so I can keep having a permit to operate PNW moving & Delivery providing employment and giving great moving experience.

This winter moving season has been slower than previous year, this caused a lot of financial strain both of the business owners (Brothers) Decided not to take regular paychecks only what was necessary to keep our households going. We also at first didn't have enough funds to pay our insurance on our regular schedule. At the end of January Cobble, Tracy reached out to me Dmitry Satir scheduling an audit for February 7th. I was working on preparing for the audit and didn't have that much time to focus on working to bring in new work. Unfortunately this caused the business to fall behind on payments. The business did try to make payments on the obligations it had as we need to pay annual report fees for 2022 payment was made in February 2024.

Where the company is as of the beginning of April we are on a better track to have the revenue to make payments that are necessary to operate the company. Few of the big expenses that the company has this month is renewal of the insurance policy for the next year. The down payment will be \$9,365.00 at the time of starting the policy, then \$3,745.16 for 10 months. We also have an annual report that we will be filing for the Household Goods annual report. The calculated fees will be \$2,500 to be paid by May 1st. I do have an outlook that we will be able to meet our obligations in time. Unfortunately if there will be any additional obligations we wouldn't be able to meet them this month.

I Dmitry Satir asking for extension on making regular payments to pay the \$9,800 We as a company are not in position to pay \$9,800 in one payment. I am trying to be a good operator to meet the necessary obligations as well as an employer for the team and being there for my 2 boys and the baby that's on the way. I do want to thank the whole UTC team. They have been helpful and understanding of me. I am working on being a better operator every day. This is my first time writing a letter like this.
