On February 14, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 07, Initial Order Granting Application in the above matter.

On February 26, 2013, counsel for Stericycle of Washington, Inc., (Stericycle) and counsel for the other protestants filed with the Commission a Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Petitions for Administrative Review (Motion). The Motion requests a three-week delay in the deadline for filing Petitions for Administrative Review until March 28, 2013.
