Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilitics (Avista or Company), on behalf of all Parties in the above referenced docket, hereby submits the First Amendment to Settlement Stipulation and Agreement ("First Amendment") to reflect Order No. 7 in Dockets UE-170485 and UG-170486, dated April 27, 2018 in Avista's recently-concluded general rate filings. Specifically, the Parties have agreed to amend Commitment No. 76, appearing at page 22 of Appendix A to the Stipulation, and Attachment A to Appendix A, to reduce the amount of deferred federal income tax benefit from \$16.7 million to \$10.4 million to be used for purposes of accelerating the depreciation of Colstrip Units 3 and 4 to reflect a "useful life" of 2027.
