You're our number one priority. We're committed to delivering the consistent, affordable power you rely on, while providing it from increasingly clean sources. Pacific Power's strategic investments and commitment to service have resulted in prices in Washington that are among the lowest in the nation.

We're writing to keep you informed about our upcoming Public Comment Hearing for Pacific Power's Clean Energy Implementation Plan. We filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for approval of our plan on December 30, 2021. The plan lists the specific actions Pacific Power will take over the next four years to advance our 2030 and 2045 clean energy directives so that we can meet the goals set by the Washington Clean Energy Transformation Act. The Commission has the authority to approve, approve with conditions, or reject Pacific Power's Plan.

The Clean Energy Implementation Plan is a four-year action plan specific to Washington customers and communities that focuses on community-based actions that move us toward meeting the Clean Energy Transformation Act's milestones. These objectives include ensuring that 100% of all retail sales of electricity are greenhouse-gas-neutral by 2030, and sourcing 100% of power from non-emitting or renewable energy generation by 2045.

Pacific Power and the Equity Advisory Group, in keeping with Pacific Power's public participation plan, co-develop and measure the potential benefits and/or impacts to communities of proposed energy resources to ensure all customers benefit from the transition to clean energy. We prioritize the equitable distribution of energy and nonenergy benefits while seeking to reduce burdens on vulnerable populations and highly impacted communities.
