Dear Representative Appleton:

Thank you for your letter of January 26<sup>th</sup> regarding the schedule of a Commission hearing on the pending application of Pacific Boat Enterprises (Mosquito Fleet) (Commission Docket No. TS-042184) and the pending application of Aqua Express (Commission Docket No. TS-050127) for passenger-only ferry service between Southworth and Seattle. You asked that the Commission delay consideration of the application until the legislature has the opportunity to debate policies for ferry transportation.

While we have expedited applications for such service in the past, several factors associated with this proceeding lead us to conclude that this process cannot quickly be conducted. Because a competing application has been filed by Aqua Express, Inc., Docket No. TS-050127, we will have to delay scheduling of both applications until they have both cleared the waiting period for notice that is specified in Commission rule, WAC 480-51-040. Based on what we know about the applications at present, we think that it is unlikely that the Commission will be in a position to make a decision on either application until after the conclusion of the regular legislative session.

When the applications are ready to be set for hearing, the adjudicative process will begin with notice for a prehearing conference before an administrative law judge to resolve matters including scheduling. There, the "formal" parties will be identified, and all parties will be able to present and discuss scheduling

specifically to receive evidence from members of the public about the need for and the effects of the proposed services.

When the formal process begins, the Commission will have limited opportunity to receive comments or inquiries because of the ban in RCW 34.05.452 on communications outside the hearing. This letter will be filed in the case file, along with your letter, and will be available to parties.
