## BACKGROUND

- On May 17, 2005, SeaTac Shuttle, LLC, (SeaTac Shuttle) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff, designated as Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 16. The proposed one-way surcharge is \$0.25, and the proposed round trip surcharge is \$0.50.
- 2 On May 24, 2005, the Commission suspended the operation of the tariff revisions pending hearing or hearings concerning all such changes and the justness and reasonableness thereof.
- 3 On June 3, 2005, SeaTac Shuttle filed with the Commission a Motion to Withdraw Request for Fuel Surcharge. SeaTac Shuttle states that because fuel prices have begun to drop they will not qualify for a fuel surcharge in the foreseeable future and the request is moot.
- 4 One June 6, 2005, SeaTac Shuttle filed with the Commission an Answer to Complaint and Order No. 01.

5 On June 6, 2005, SeaTac Shuttle filed with the Commission a request to withdraw its filing for a Fuel Surcharge.

## ORDER

6 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the request of SeaTac Shuttle, LLC, to withdraw its Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 16 is granted without prejudice.
