## TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 30, 2016, Cheryl Ann Ball d/b/a Acme Moving Labor (Acme Moving or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington (Application). On October 19, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing. On October 31, 2016, Acme Moving requested a hearing. On November 23, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding set for December 6, 2016, at 1:30 p.m.
