RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Can't Stop Moving, LLC*  
Commission Staff's Request to Cancel Payment Plan

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 1, 2017, the commission assessed a \$51,900 penalty for safety related violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-100, WAC 480-15-560, and WAC 480-15-570 against Can't Stop Moving, LLC. On June 19, 2017, the commission reduced the penalty to \$25,400 and suspended \$15,400 of the \$25,400 penalty for two years which left \$10,000 due and payable. The commission approved a payment plan on July 5, 2017, allowing the company to pay the \$10,000 owed in twenty monthly payments of \$500 each. The plan stipulated that if the company failed to pay any installment in a timely manner, the unpaid balance and the \$15,400 suspended portion of the penalty would both become immediately due and payable.

To date, Can't Stop Moving, LLC has made nine of the 11 payments due. Of the nine payments made three have been timely. The other six payments were between one and 22 days late. The April 16, 2018, payment is now more than 30 days past due and the May 15, 2018, payment has yet to be received by the commission. Staff requests the commission enforce Order 02 and require Can't Stop Moving, LLC to immediately pay the unpaid balance of \$4,500 as well as the \$15,400 suspended portion.
