RE: In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against Paulino Jose Gonzalez and Veronica Luna, d/b/a Universal Moving, Docket TG-190940

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 1, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Initial Order Cancelling Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Approving Settlement Agreement (Order 02) against Paulino Jose Gonzalez and Veronica Luna, d/b/a Universal Moving, (Universal Moving or Company). Order 02 assessed a penalty of \$2,000 against Universal Moving, \$1,500 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: (a) Universal Moving refrains from operating as a solid waste collection carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (b) Universal Moving must pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On October 4, 2021, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended, and that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a solid waste collection carrier without a certificate. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Universal Moving has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$1,500 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
