2 matter. At this time, WRRRA does not anticipate calling any witnesses at hearing but reserves the
3 right to do so should issues brought by the primary parties result in the presentation of witnesses
4 by WRRRA being helpful to the Commission.

5 5) WRRRA's position in this action is expected to be in support of the Protestants.
