**COMES NOW** the Washington Refuse and Recycling Association (WRRA) and respectfully petitions to intervene in the above matter pursuant to WAC 480-07-355, and in doing so alleges as follows:

- 1) Proposed intervenor's address is: 4160 6th Ave. SE, Suite 205, Lacey, Washington 98503.
- 2) WRRA is a trade association representing the vast majority of regulated solid waste collection companies in Washington State. As such, it has taken part as a party, intervenor or interested party in virtually every WUTC hearing regarding solid waste since the inception of regulation of solid waste. Matters involving regulation of the solid waste industry are of interest to the members of WRRA, who would not be parties in this action. The issues presented in this action are of substantial interest to the solid waste industry in Washington in general, and to all individual G-certificate holders who are members of WRRA.
- 3) A trade association such as WRRA is included in the definition of "person" in WAC 480-07-340(1)(a). WAC 480-07-355(1)(a) provides that "any person" may file a Petition to Intervene.
