enacted the Laws of 2020, chapter 170, which provided the UTC with revised regulatory authority over train crew size. The							

legislation also added new sections to and repeals specific sections of chapter 81.40 RCW, necessitating a rulemaking to

define Class I railroads, provide automatic waivers, and establish a process for UTC-ordered crew size increases.
