I noticed that I missed commenting on the insurance requirement fee that is identified in the net metering rule being proposed during the WUTC's rulemaking process. I am still inquiring as to whether the proposed \$200,000 insurance policy is too onerous. I wanted to note that Vermont has completed several of its investigations relating to electricity restructuring. The attached net metering form indicates a requirement that a residential account needs a \$100,000 insurance policy and a farm or non-residential facility needs a \$300,000 policy to participate in net metering.
