REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING
(Set for Thursday, May 3, 2018, at 12 noon – Colfax)

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities*, Docket U-170970

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 14, 2017, Hydro One Limited (Hydro One), acting through Olympus Equity LLC, an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary, and Avista Corporation (Avista) filed their Joint Application for an Order Authorizing Proposed Transaction with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) whereby Olympus Equity LLC would acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Avista, and Avista would become a direct, wholly-owned subsidiary of Olympus Equity LLC and an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Hydro One.


On October 25, 2017, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 02). In Order 02, the Commission stated that the time and place for public comment hearings would be determined at a later date.

The Commission gave notice on January 26, 2018, that it would conduct a series of four public comment hearings on April 23, 2018, April 24, 2018, May 2, 2018, and May 3, 2018, in Spokane, Colville, Othello, and Colfax, Washington, respectively. The first two public comment hearings were held as previously scheduled. Following the second public comment hearing, the Commission recognized for the first time an error in the time frame established for the fourth public comment hearing, an error the Commission corrects by this notice.

Specifically, notice of the fourth public comment hearing should have established a time frame for taking comments in Colfax, Washington from 12:00 noon until 3:00 p.m., rather than from “12 p.m., ending no later than 4:30 p.m.” **This Notice accordingly revises the timeframe for the public comment hearing in Colfax, Washington, on Thursday, May 3, 2018, to read as follows:**

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That another public hearing in this matter will be held on Thursday, May 3, 2018, beginning at 12 noon, in the Auditorium of the Whitman County Parks and Recreation Building, 310 Main St., Colfax, Washington.

The Commission will begin taking comments from members of the public at 12:00 noon, ending no later than 3:00 p.m.
