Dear Jeff Killip:

On April 24, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 07 in Docket UG-230393. Order 07, among other things, rejected the initial tariff proposals by Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) and required PSE to make a compliance filing consistent with the Order. The Commission ordered PSE in that compliance filing to report: any Notices of Violations (NOVs) issued by the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency; PSE's response to any NOVs; a list of any Incentive Payments made to or liquidated damages received from the Operator pursuant to the Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Agreement for Tacoma LNG (O&M Services Agreement); and a list of any repairs, modifications, or improvements made to the flare or flare bypass.

On January 30, 2025, in compliance with Order 07, PSE filed its biannual report for the Tacoma LNG Facility, which covered the period between July 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024. Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed the Company's compliance filing. Staff believes that the Tacoma LNG Facility Report complies with the requirements of Order 07, entered April 24, 2024. The next report will be submitted in July 2025.
