

- 4 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That in accordance with WAC 480-09-700(1)(a), the Commission has determined that good cause exists for this matter to be heard upon shortened notice.
- 5 NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN That, in accordance with WAC 480-09-530(4)(a), an emergency hearing and a prehearing conference in this matter will be held beginning at **9:30 a.m., on Friday, April 12, 2002**, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Room 206, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
- 6 The purpose of the emergency hearing is to consider pursuant to RCW 34.05.479 and WAC 480-09-510 what are the circumstances giving rise to the complaint and whether they constitute a dangerous condition that must be terminated or corrected or whether they constitute a situation involving an immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare that requires emergency action by the Commission.
- 7 In furtherance of the consideration of this question, the complainant must file with the Commission and deliver to the respondent and the Commission Staff no later than the close of business on April 10, 2002, a statement of the evidence on which it relies, and a statement of its reasoning for its contention that the matter falls within the emergency adjudication provisions of the APA and Commission rules.
- 8 The purpose of the prehearing conference is to consider formulating the issues in the proceeding, and to determine other matters to aid in its disposition, as specified in WAC 480-09-460. The time and place for any further evidentiary hearing will be set at the prehearing conference or by later written notice. Appearances will be taken.
- 9 If any party or witness needs an interpreter or other assistance, please fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission.
- 10 NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT ANY PARTY WHO FAILS TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING SET BY THIS NOTICE, OR ANY OTHER STAGE OF THIS PROCEEDING, MAY BE HELD IN DEFAULT IN ACCORDANCE WITH RCW 34.05.440. THE PARTIES ARE FURTHER ADVISED THAT THE SANCTION PROVISIONS OF WAC 480-09-700(4) ARE SPECIFICALLY INVOKED.
