- On September 12, 2003, Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc. (Eschelon) filed with the Commission a Petition for Enforcement of Section 252(i) and Complaint against Qwest Corporation (Qwest) pursuant to the Commission's Interpretive and Policy Statement in Docket No. UT-990355 and WAC 480-09-530. The complaint alleges that Qwest charges Eschelon higher rates for UNE-Star than it charges to McLeodUSA. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the complaint, which is available for inspection at the Commission's office located at Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. It is appropriate that the matters raised in the pleadings be brought for hearing before the Commission.
- Hearing in this matter is being held pursuant to RCW 80.36.610, authorizing the Commission to take actions, conduct hearings, and enter orders as permitted or contemplated for a state commission under the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, P.L. 104-104 (110 Stat. 56). Statutes and rules cited in the complaint include 47 U.S.C. § 251(b), 47 U.S.C. § 251(c), 47 U.S.C. § 251(h), 47 U.S.C. § 251(i), 47 U.S.C. § 252(c), 47 U.S.C. § 252(i), RCW 80.36.610, and WAC 480-09-530. In addition to the foregoing, statutes and rules involved include those within chapter 80.36 RCW, chapter 480-09 WAC, and chapter 480-120 WAC. The issues involved are generally stated above and more specifically contained in the complaint.
