

public service companies, including solid waste companies. *RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 81.04 RCW; Chapter 81.28 RCW and Chapter 81.77 RCW.*

- 4 (2) Stanley's Sanitary Service is a solid waste company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 5 (3) Stanley's Sanitary Service is subject to the provisions of RCW 81.04.080 and WAC 480-70-071 requiring solid waste companies to file an annual report by May 1st of each year.
- 6 (4) WAC 480-70-051 provides that the Commission may grant an exemption from the provisions of any rule in Chapter 480-70 WAC, if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. WAC 480-70-071 (1)(c) provides that the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1st due date if the Commission receives a request for extension before May 1st.
- 7 (5) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 12, 2004.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition filed in Docket No. TG-040800 by Stanley's Sanitary Service on April 30, 2004, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The exemption sought by Stanley, Fred W. and Crystal L. dba Stanley's Sanitary Service for an extension until May 31, 2004, to file its 2003 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Stanley, Fred W. and Crystal L. dba Stanley's Sanitary Service to file its 2003 annual report by May 31, 2004, may result in the Commission invoking provisions of Chapter 81.04 RCW that provide for penalty assessments.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Stanley, Fred W. and Crystal L. dba Stanley's Sanitary Service to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
