Rainier View Water Company, Inc. has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to put an irrigation tariff in place. The purpose of the tariff is to limit the amount of water to those customers who use water for irrigation only. The limitation is that customers should use only the average daily use of all customers on the water system, which is 365 gallons per day. The tariff allows Rainier View to discontinue service to those persons who use water for irrigation that exceeds 365 gallons per day during the summer months. If approved, this tariff will be effective on August $30^{\rm th}$, 2004
